Nordic Aviation Capital A/S purchases Three New ATR 72-500 aircraft from ATR for lease to TRIP Linhas Aéreas of Brazil

Nordic Aviation Capital A/S (NAC) is pleased to confirm that it has completed the purchase of three new ATR 72-500 aircraft (MSN 785, 846 and 891) from ATR for lease to TRIP Linhas Aéreas of Brazil.

This is a landmark transaction in NAC's history as it is the first purchase of factory new aircraft from ATR. TRIP Linhas Aéreas is the second largest operator of ATRs in the world with a fleet of 27 ATR aircraft and 5 Embraer E-175 jets.

Nordic Aviation Capital A/S (NAC), was established in Denmark in 1990. Its principal headquarters in Billund, Denmark is complemented by regional offices in the US, Ireland, France and Switzerland.

Nordic Aviation Capital A/S is a global aircraft leasing company dedicated to the worldwide sale, purchasing and financing of commercial jet and turboprop aircraft. NAC is currently the largest turboprop lessor in the world and will mark its 20th birthday in 2010.
